MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Membership

Membership is open to anyone 18 years of age and over. Dues are paid annually with the fiscal year beginning in July and ending the June of the following year. Prorated memberships are available to first time members. (*Refer to Policy and Rules for classes of membership rates*).

Our Mission

The Vacaville Art League is a nonprofit organization dedicated to the development and promotion of the visual arts. Our purposes are: To create an atmosphere that encourages community participation in the visual arts. To provide artists with exhibition space and opportunities to share and develop creative skills. To stimulate and educate members of the community by bringing an awareness and appreciation of fine art through exhibitions, shows, workshops, classes and demonstrations.

History

The Vacaville Art League was formed in 1963 with over 100 people attending the first meeting. However, there was no facility to meet in, nor a place to display the artists' work. In May of 1965, the city agreed to lease the circa 1880's Segura home to the art league, but the old Victorian needed much work. Many of the members rolled up their sleeves and prepared the building. Fund-raising projects generated enough money for the materials needed. Local businesses generously gave many supplies. On March 16, 1968 the Vacaville Art Gallery opened its doors for the first time.

Art League Board and Staff

The Vacaville Art League is organized under an elected board of directors, all board members maintain current membership with the Vacaville Art League. The VAL Board of Directors sets policy and governs the organization. The Vacaville Art Gallery staff consists of a Gallery Manager and Gallery Assistants.

Members Meetings

Members meetings are bi-monthly and are conducted at the gallery at 7 pm the third Wednesday of the month. Please attend these meetings as this is where the latest information and ideas are shared. Demonstrations or talks are scheduled at the conclusion of business. Member meeting months are Jan., Mar., May, June (elections), July, Sep., and Nov. Members are requested to attend a minimum of two meetings per year.

Gallery Exhibits

The Vacaville Art Gallery changes exhibits monthly. Shows ranging from members' exhibits (*refer to screening policy*) to juried and non-juried open exhibitions remain in place all month, offering visitors a continuous display of fine quality work. Monthly themes for member exhibits allows our entire membership the opportunity to exhibit more frequently.

Opening Receptions

There is an opening reception each month (exception is Annual Student Show) which gives the artist the opportunity to meet and talk with the public and other artists. The receptions are held the first Friday of every month from 7 to 9 pm.

Gift Shop

The Gallery has a gift shop which sells smaller works of art and note cards created by Vacaville Art League members. A special membership rate is offered for members only wanting to display items in the gift shop. (*Refer to Policy and Rules for guidelines*)

Ulatis Community Center

The Ulatis Community Center is located at the Vacaville Cultural Center, 1000 Ulatis Drive in Vacaville. Bi-monthly solo artist exhibits are available to Vacaville Art League members. (*Refer to Policy and Rules for guidelines*)

Other Venues

The VAL member has the opportunity to show at other venues located within and outside the city of Vacaville.

ArtWorks

Members receive the Vacaville Art League's newsletter *ArtWorks*. This quarterly newsletter keeps the members abreast of league news, announcements, local calls for entry and gallery exhibit information. An artist from our membership is spotlighted in every issue.

Website

The VAL website is where up-to-date information is available for members and non-members. Members have the opportunity to link their personal website to the VAL website for free. For a nominal fee a personal website can be created with samples of artwork and an artist statement/bio. Files are maintained of members' work by the Gallery Manager and is available to curators, collectors and the general public. Artists should submit a bio and/or statement along with samples of work, either slide or photograph, to the gallery.

By helping with the Juried Art Show, demonstrating art techniques at member meetings or assisting at the monthly receptions, our member involvement keeps VAL vibrant.
